

## Horticulture Winter Burns?



Anti-transpirants are used to protect plants from drying out when under water stress: drought, transplants and winter when drying winds and frozen ground deprive plants of their natural moisture intake.



Can Help Prevent Winter Damage to Evergreen Trees and Shrubs

Wilt-Pruf is a pine oil emulsion that is non-hazardous and biodegradable. It acts as a protective coating, holding in moisture on plant foliage and stems, substantially reducing water loss.

Wilt-Pruf spray dries to form a clear, colorless, flexible, gloss film without interfering with plant growth or materially affecting respiration, osmosis, or photosynthesis.

### Types of Foliage for Use

- Rhododendrons
- Azaleas
- Hollies

- Boxwoods
- Laurels
- Christmas Trees
- Wreaths

### **When to Apply**

For winter kill protection, spray in late fall when temperature is above freezing so that spray will not freeze on foliage. Can also use during winter on days above freezing.

For Christmas trees, wreaths, and greens spray as above. In all cases, Wilt-Pruf must be allowed to dry outdoors in daylight since it's a film forming polymer and needs ultraviolet rays in order for the spray to set up or polymerize.
